I wish to inform you that we are not able to get out till tomorrow we will not leave here till in the afternoon we are getting a full load or will have a full load before we leave but Prices are low we are anxious to make money and cannot depend upon getting any freight below here. You may send down the Can of milk and 2 jars of lard and my clothes and overcoat ~~I will bring down and hand to some one on the shore~~ I will hand a note for you to some one on the Shore at Shousetown. I spoke to Russell about Money and you had better Call on him as soon in the week as possible as Saturday is pay day for the hands and he promised to have some let on that you are in great need and you Can fork over to me all you get when I come home
